General Fund Scholarship Policy

Bethel College exists to provide exemplary postsecondary education from a biblical perspective in order to prepare students spiritually, practically, and academically for professional and lay ministry. Bethel College believes that no student who wishes to attend the college should be denied the opportunity because of limited financial resources. The Director of Financial Aid is available to counsel with you and your family regarding financial planning.

Bethel College provides scholarships for students who demonstrate financial need. To be considered for Bethel College scholarship you must submit to Bethel College your and you parents' copies of federal tax returns. Scholarship is granted on a semester basis and your need is re-evaluated each semester. The Financial Aid Committee will review each student's application for scholarship and will determine the candidates based on such criteria:

- Financial need
- A gifted student with intention to go in the ministry
- A student maintains GPA above 3.0
