

Policy on Students Needing Additional Educational Support

Students identified as needing additional educational support should be referred to the Dean of Students. When students are identified during their admission process the potential student can only be admitted on a provisional basis. Student may be referred to the Dean through one of several methods.

Sources of Referral :

1. Through transcripts submitted during the application process.
(provisional acceptance only)
2. Test low scores on academic tests. (SAT/ACT)
3. Mid-course evaluation during a semester. (Student at Risk Form)
4. Self referral.
5. Instructor referral. (Student at Risk Form)
